Chile's Story

In a complex global scenario where we have seen an increase in droughts and floods as a result of the extreme weather changes of the last decade, many communities around the world have been left without water or with minimal supply; aggravating a crisis that affects both socio-economic development and life itself.

Once known as a water-rich country, Chile has been struck for the past decade by the worst drought in its history, with rain levels dropping by 20 to 40 per cent. Meanwhile, agriculture, mining and other economic activities have been soaking up its rivers, glaciers and aquifers, putting it at the top of the list of countries that will be facing high water stress by 2040, according to the World Resources Institute.

Chile is coming to grips with a challenge that many other countries sooner or later will have to face as global warming

continues to shrink the water supply. Who should get to own water?

- Ecologists have labeled the past 10 years as a mega-drought, which has seen rainfall deficits as high as 70 percent in the Metropolitan region, leading the Chilean government to implement agricultural emergency zones in over one-third of the nation's provinces.
- In 2016, Chile became the first Latin American country to achieve 100 percent basic sanitation coverage for its population, a major feat.
- As of 2017, 98.64 percent of the Chilean population possesses access to clean, household water, one of the highest coverage rates in Latin America.
